Our review indicates that there are no known religious or culturally significant sites within the selected project area. **We have no objection to the proposed project.**

We ask that if any archaeological materials (artifacts, subsurface features, etc.) are discovered during the construction process that work in the immediate area be halted until an archaeologist can view and assess the finds. Furthermore, we ask that if any human remains are accidentally unearthed during the course of the project that you cease development immediately and inform the Delaware Tribe of Indians of the inadvertent discovery.
