

2023 Photo Contest Rules

- 1. **Eligibility** The contest is open to any amateur or professional photographer except employees, Board Directors or Commissioners of the Erie Canalway National Heritage Corridor and members of their immediate families; New York Power Authority and New York State Canal Corporation employees and members of their immediate families; and photo contest judges and members of their immediate families.
- 2. **Locale –** All images must be taken within the Erie Canalway National Heritage Corridor which includes the Erie, Oswego, Cayuga/Seneca, Champlain Canals and surrounding communities. A map of the heritage corridor and a list of corridor communities can be found at www.eriecanalway.org.

3. **Deadline –** All entries must be <u>postmarked</u> no later than **August 25, 2023**.

- 5. **Entry Forms –** Entries must be accompanied by a completed and signed Entry Form (available at www.eriecanalway.org). All images must be listed on a single-Entry Form.
- 6. Number of Images Allowed A maximum of three (3) images per photographer is allowed.
- 7. **Categories** Entrants must place their images in one of the four categories listed below. The judges reserve the right to recategorize any entry.

CATEGORY	WHAT TO PHOTOGRAPH
On the Water	On-water activities and scenes, e.g., boating, paddling, fishing, tugs & barges, historic vessels, on-water events and festivals.
Along the Trail	Cyclists, walkers, strollers, and activities or scenes along the Erie Canalway Trail.
Canal Communities	Historic downtowns, distinctive architecture, farmers markets, events, and scenes taken in canal communities.
Classic Canal	When you see it, you know it—photos that could be taken only here; photos of engineering marvels, canal structures, or other scenes that show the distinctive sense of place of the Erie Canalway.

- 8. **Enhancing your Images-** While you may crop or perform color correction on your images, the judging team discourages over-amplifying the color. We are looking for images that reflect the scene as it appears in reality. You may use HDR camera settings, but again, please avoid over enhancing the image.
- Entry Identification <u>Each image must be adequately identified</u>.
 Image File Names: <u>PLEASE label</u> your photographs starting with your <u>Last Name</u>, then First Name and <u>ENTRY NUMBER</u> (e.g Smith_Beth_Entry1, Smith_Beth_Entry2, Smith_Beth_Entry3)

10. Image Resolution/Orientation

Digital images can be in color or black and white.

Images must be a minimum resolution of 300 DPI (dots per inch) and no smaller than 3072 x 2304 pixels (or 10.24 x 7.68 inches). Images should be in RGB color format and be submitted as JPG (at high quality) or TIFF files. Do not resample small files to fit requirements, as it will compromise the quality of the image.

Images must be in landscape (horizontal) orientation to fit the format of our calendar.



11. Submission Options - Submissions that do not follow these requirements may be rejected.

<u>Email Entries</u>: A completed entry form should be attached to an email with up to three images per photographer. Three separate emails may be needed if image file sizes are too large. If additional emails are needed, the entry form only needs to be attached to one email. All emailed entries will receive a confirmation email after the images have been matched to the completed entry form.

<u>Disc/Flash Drive Entries</u>: Submit entry form and digital images on one compact disc or one flash drive. A printed entry form may be included in with the mailed disc or flash drive. Discs and flash drives must contain <u>only</u> images submitted for the contest. The photographer's name and "Erie Canalway 2023 Photo Contest" should be written directly on the compact disc. Flash drives should have the photographer's name and "Erie Canalway 2023 Photo Contest" securely attached in the best manner possible that does not affect the flash drive's performance. All mailed entries will receive a confirmation email after the images have been matched to the completed entry form.

- 12. **Model Release –** Images containing recognizable people must be accompanied by a model release form (available at www.eriecanalway.org) signed by the subject or a parent or legal guardian, if subject is under 18 years of age.
- 13. Judging Entries will be judged on the basis of creativity, photographic quality, and effectiveness in conveying the beauty and/or unique character of the canalway in one of the contest categories. An Erie Canalway National Heritage Corridor panel will judge the entries and all contest decisions are final. First, second, and third place winners will be selected in each of the four categories identified above. Honorable mentions will be awarded at the discretion of the judges. Winners will be announced no later than October 31, 2023.
- 14. **Winning Photos –** The winning images with appropriate credit will appear in the Erie Canalway National Heritage Corridor 2024 Calendar and on the Erie Canalway National Heritage Corridor website. Winners will also receive a copy of the calendar and other prize to be determined.
- 15. **Photographer's Rights** Each photographer will retain all rights to any image submitted including ownership if applicable other than those rights licensed in the next sentence. By entering the contest, each photographer hereby grants to the Erie Canalway National Heritage Corridor (i) a nonexclusive, worldwide, irrevocable, royalty-free license to reproduce, distribute, publicly display the images submitted to the Erie Canalway National Heritage Corridor, and (ii) the right to use the photographer's name, city and state of residence in promotions and other publications.
- 16. **Other –** Images, regardless of medium, will not be returned. Do not send your only file of an image. The Erie Canalway National Heritage Corridor is not responsible for any material lost, damaged, or misdirected in the mail.
